

Minutes from drama booster meeting on January 18, 2012

1. Zoe discussed the summer show and estimated that the up front cost would be about \$2000.00. The expected cost for each student would be \$300.. The dates for the summer show are July 27th and 28th. Mrs. Dillard is deciding between Oliver and Seusical for the summer production. Mrs. Van Slyke is on board for the show.
2. The young actor's workshop now has a producer. Lorie Ellis has "volunteered" to assist with the "Junior Grand" which will occur the last week in June. More information to follow.
3. Zoe will pay the boosters \$50.00 which was the amount paid by the boosters to RCP as a deposit for the costumes.
4. The date set for the creative coffeehouse is Friday January 27th at 7:30.
5. Urgent request was made by Zoe for all students who have scripts of Beauty and the Beast to please return them NOW.
6. Zoe stated that there was no need for booster support for the upcoming VSHL. The boosters did however decide to do concessions. Mary is taking charge of buying food (hot dogs and pizza) to sell.
7. Evening of One Act Plays will take place on February 8th at 7:30. The cost of tickets is \$5.00.
8. The children's show this year will be The Princess and the Pea. The dates of the show are March 23rd at 7:30 and March 24th at 10 a.m. There will be programs but no ads. The student bios need to be completed by Feb. 24th and should consist of 25-30 word. Please include name, grade, and role in show. The design needs to be completed by Feb. 3rd. The set will be completed during tech class. The costume committee is headed up by Tessa and Hannah. Requests will be sent out for volunteers for ushers (2), concession (1), and trinkets (1).
9. The boosters made a profit of \$1277.311 on Beauty and the Beast.
10. Auditions for Pride and prejudice will take place o Feb 21-23rd. This is a big show and it is also our cappies show. Mary is thinking about a "high tea" for our Cappie luncheon.
